



ELECTION OF ONE TRUSTEE

In accordance with the Trust Order, Montgomery Morrison retires this year and is available for re-election.

Persons interested in being nominated for this position are invited to submit their nomination form to the Returning Officer. The minimum qualifications for nominees for election are:

- (a) Seven years experience in Maori Land Governance or administration or in law, commerce or management, or
- (b) An NZQA approved tertiary qualification in Maori Land administration or business administration, or management.

Nominations can only be made on the official nomination form which is available from the Returning Officer or from the website <http://rotorua.deloitte.co.nz>

If more than one nomination is received an election will be held by postal ballot, by poll vote. The highest polling candidate will be recommended to the Maori Land Court for appointment.

Voting Papers will be mailed to registered Owners by Friday 4th October 2019.
